Very Rev. Archpriest Bohdan HLADIO

Fr. Bohdan Hladio was born in Sewickley, Pennsylvania in 1957. He did his theological studies at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, where he was a member of the “Tamburitzans” performing ensemble. Following university he worked as a teacher and instructor of folk music and dance. He met his wife, Tania Pidlynsny, while working with a Ukrainian Dance group in Toronto. They were married in 1984, and have three children.

He was ordained deacon in 1986 and priest in 1988. Fr. Bohdan has served parishes in Toronto, Hamilton, and Oshawa. From 2005 till 2008 he served as chancellor of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada in Winnipeg, Manitoba. He currently serves as pastor of St. John the Baptist Ukrainian Orthodox Church in Oshawa, Ontario.

From 1998 until 2012 he wrote a monthly column for the “Herald”, the official organ of the UOCC, and was a member of the Community Editorial Board of the Hamilton Spectator from 2000 until 2002. Currently, he writes a monthly column entitled “Against the Current” for young adults which is found on the web-site of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA, and is a contributor to the monthly “Urbanicity” in Hamilton, Ontario. “Northopraxis”, a collection of his articles, was published by Holy Dormition Press in 2009.

Fr. Bohdan is also a sought after speaker and retreat leader.
